Tier 1 delegation



The delegation of 4.6.e164.arpa

- Application made to RIPE or ITU TSB
- Requires National Administration agreement to comply with Interim ITU procedures for delegation of codes

The delegation of 4.6.e164.arpa

The options

- Award to a single registry
- Share
 - Meta Tier 1 function
 - Split by number range or other method

Issues

- Who decides/ who advises?
 - Government
 - Industry
 - other
- How?
 - Imposed selection
 - Competition (set criteria, beauty competition, auction, sealed bid.....etc)

- On what legal authority is the choice made?
- If it's a competitive assessment who selects, adjudicates, advises?
- Who pays any costs and how ?

The UK experience – the trial

Tier 1 shared between 3 Registry's for trial

- Number space divided equally
- Meta Registry to delegate sections
- Added complexity
- More processing work for registrars
- EPP interface favoured but not implemented for trial

The UK experience – after the trial

- Require ITT process to start
- No legal basis to start process!
- Costs for ITT/Evaluation team/contract
- Loss of time = loss of impetus
